"Experiential learning - auditing beyond theory"

The Department of Medical Education and the Department of Surgery, Symbiosis Medical College for women & Symbiosis University Hospital & Research Centre, conducted an audit presentation by students on "Experiential learning - auditing beyond theory "at Moringa Auditorium. The half-day event was held on June 26, 2024, from 2:30 PM to 4:30 PM.

There were five audit presentations by students of MBBS-Phase III part II students, followed by intervention from faculty from the Departments of Surgery, Anaesthesia, Microbiology, and Forensic Medicine.
