- ✓ Scatter plot and Correlation
- ✓ Application of Chi-square test for categorical variables
- ✓ Application of t-test for quantitative data
- ✓ Analysis of variance (ANOVA)

The course will consist of lectures and hands on training on data handling, analysis and interpretation etc.
