

SOP ON MENTORING

1. **Introduction.** The role of mentors in shaping the future generation of medical professionals cannot be overstated. Mentors not only provide guidance and support but also serve as role models, imparting invaluable wisdom and experience to their mentees. By assuming the roles of guardians, friends, guides, and philosophers, mentors play a multifaceted role in the holistic development of their mentees. In an institution like Symbiosis Medical College for Women (SMCW), where the emphasis is not only on academic excellence but also on nurturing well-rounded individuals, the mentorship program becomes even more crucial. It helps students navigate the complexities of both their academic and personal lives, instilling in them the values and skills necessary to excel in their chosen field and make meaningful contributions to society.

2. Symbiosis Medical College for Women has been training medical students from 2020. The senior students of this institution have been role models for their peers in various fields. This has been possible due to concerted efforts of dedicated faculty members to mould SMCW students into good professionals and ideal citizens. Therefore, the role of experienced faculty members in mentoring young entrants to the SMCW is essential for fulfilling its goal of nurturing top-tier medical professionals who possess not just expertise, but also compassion, ethics, and a dedication to community service. The mentorship of SMCW students therefore is an important facet of comprehensive medical education imparted in this institution. The designated mentor will thus serve as a guardian, friend, guide and philosopher for the group of allotted mentees.

3. **Aim.** The aim of this SOP is to lay down guidelines in order to formalize the process of mentoring.

5. **Role of a Mentor.** The mentor is a **role model** who provides support to the mentee depending on his/her needs. The mentors are expected to orient the mentees during their stay in the college. The mentor should be able to assist the mentee to realize his/her fullest potential. The assistance can be extended by the mentor for academic needs, psychological support or advice with personal exigencies. The mentors are expected to be their guiding force. The mentor should be able to motivate the mentee to be involved in professional/academic activities for the benefit of the mentee. This apart the mentor can provide the necessary networking to the mentee to facilitate her academic interests thereby increasing their experience and skill by collaborative work. The general guidelines on the role of a mentor are given in **Appendix A**.

6. **Selection of Mentors.** All Faculty above Assistant Professor with More than 2 Years of Experience at SMCW, Lavale, Pune will be on the panel of mentors. The responsibility of mentoring is **purely voluntary**. The eligible faculty members joining SMCW **should** communicate their option to **volunteer out of mentorship** to the Dean through their respective HOD. The Heads of Department will supervise junior mentors from their departments in addition to their allotted mentees.

7. **Maintenance of Mentorship Database.** The database of mentors will be maintained by the Student Section based on the inputs from Dean Office (HR) and HOD of teaching departments. The records of faculty members nominated as mentors will be maintained in each department under the arrangement of respective HOD.

8. **Allotment of Mentees.** The allotment of mentees to mentors will be coordinated by the Student Section under the aegis of Deputy Dean, Student Welfare. The fresh mentees will be allotted to respective mentors during **FC Orientation - Introduction of Mentor & Mentee** at the beginning of each admission year after the admissions are finalized.

(a) The list of mentees will be updated every year to exclude the medical students who have passed their Final MBBS Examinations and to include the newly admitted medical students. The updating of the mentee database will be done by the Student Section under the aegis of Deputy Dean, Student Welfare.

(b) The ideal **1:2 or 1:3** ratio of mentors to mentees **per batch** will be implemented. The **ratio** of mentors to mentees will not **exceed 1:3** for **each batch** (The maximum number of mentees should be 15/mentor).



(c) The mentors and their respective departments will assume **guardianship** of these mentees as long as they remain **on the rolls** of the college.

9. **Allotment / Change of Mentors.** Whenever mentors are required to be relieved of their responsibilities, the concerned HOD will forward the request to the Student Section along with the name of faculty member nominated to relieve the mentor. In case suitable reliever is not available in the Dept, Administrative Officer, SMCW will allot a relief from available faculty. The change of mentors will be notified through Office Order and the mentorship list updated accordingly at Student Section.

10. Mentee may exercise the option to change her mentor by applying to the Student Section for the same. The request can be granted by the Dean depending on the merits of the case.

11. **Maintenance of Records.** The mentorship records are required to be maintained by each mentor. The Student Section will make available to each mentor the personal details of each mentee along with relevant family details. The mentor will be required to maintain a record of interactions with the mentees. Each student will be handed over a Mentoring Log Book (Attached as **Annexure 1**). The records will be put up for perusal of HOD **bi-monthly**. The HOD will place the mentorship records for the perusal of Dean once **every term**. The mentor may, however, bring any specific issue to the notice of Deputy Dean, Student Welfare and Dean anytime.

12. **College Mentoring Committee.** The College Mentoring Committee will be constituted of the following faculty members and staff under the Dean, SMCW as the Chairperson and will be called the '**College Mentoring Committee**'. The Chairperson will be responsible for overseeing the committee's activities, providing guidance, and ensuring its effectiveness. The Dy Dean Student Welfare will be the Member Secretary. He will be responsible for documenting the committee's activities, implementing guidelines, and ensuring its effectiveness.

- (i) One HOD from I, II & III (Parts – I & II) MBBS Phases. The HOD will be nominated by rotation for tenure of one academic year.
- (ii) Dy Dean Administration.
- (iii) Dy Dean Academics.
- (iv) HOD, Dept of Psychiatry.
- (v) Coordinator, MEU.
- (vi) Campus Administrator, Medical Campus, Lavale Hill Base.
- (vii) Psychological Counsellor/Jr Counsellor.

13. **Bi Monthly / Monthly Meetings of the College Mentoring Committee.**

The Monthly Meetings of the College Mentoring Committee will be convened by the member secretary to meet **at least twice a month during the fresher term** and **at least**

once a month thereafter. The meetings will be attended **only by the concerned mentors and HOD, who have sought to address a grievance/problem**. The member secretary may invite other members as per the agenda. Common agenda for each meeting will consist of points from the mentees, mentors and HOD; followed by directions of the Chairperson. Points from the mentees, mentors and HOD will be sought at least **05** days before each meeting. Strict confidentiality of information regarding identity of the mentee or affected party will be maintained. Identity is not required to be disclosed and the focus should be on the nature of the occurrence/grievance/problem and the possible solutions. Record of the minutes of the meetings will be maintained by the member secretary. General outline of the Mentorship Programme is attached for reference as **Annexure 2**.

14. **Biannual Meetings of the College Mentoring Committee.** The Biannual meetings of the College Mentoring Committee will be attended by **all the mentors and HOD**. Points from the mentees, mentors and HOD will be sought at least **05** days before each meeting. The agenda for these meetings would be the same as for the Bi Monthly/Monthly meetings. Strict confidentiality will be maintained. Record of the minutes of the meetings will be maintained by the member secretary.

15. **Role of HOD in Mentoring.** The HOD are expected to play a major role in the mentorship of SMCW students. They are expected to guide the mentors from their experience and expertise in dealing with problems faced by students. The HOD will also ensure that all mentors are supported in their endeavors to carry out their task with dedicated time and taking their feedback.

16. The HOD will hold **monthly** interactions with all the mentors of their respective departments to review problems faced by mentees and mentors. These proceedings of this **Departmental Mentors Forum** should be recorded and preserved. HOD will peruse records maintained by mentors during these meetings. The grievances which cannot be resolved or merit deliberations in a higher forum should be brought before the Bi Monthly/Monthly or Biannual meetings of the College Mentoring Committee.

17. The HOD have another important role to play i.e. review the **academic performance** of all med students pursuing studies in the particular phase of training during MBBS Course and guide them. The information on academic performance should be shared with the mentors in confidence. List of mentors and allotted mentees will be provided to all HOD.

18. HOD are required to **groom future mentors**. It is the responsibility of HOD to include junior faculty members (Sr Residents & Tutors) into the mentorship process to ensure that they are well versed with the responsibilities of mentoring as and when they are promoted as senior faculty.



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19. **Protected Time for Mentor - Mentee Interactions.** Time slot of **03:30 PM – 4:30 PM on Saturdays** will be included in the **block training program** for Mentor - Mentee interactions. These interactions can be conducted at a venue and time to be decided by each mentor as per his/her convenience and that of the mentees. Mentors should meet mentees at least **once a fortnight as a group**. These interactions are required to be informal and friendly to create an environment of trust and mutual respect.
20. **Special Interactions Between Mentors and Mentees.** Mentors can organize special interactions on birthdays or celebrate excellence in curricular and extra/co-curricular activities. If a mentor faces any problem, he/she may approach Dy Dean Student Welfare for support. Handouts for Mentors and Mentees are attached as **Annexure 3 and 4**.
21. **Lunch / Dinner in Students Mess.** The mentors are required to periodically visit the Students Mess after informing the Campus Administrator, Medical Campus, Lavale Hill Base and interact with mentees over lunch/dinner. Anecdotal messages on etiquettes and grooming can be exchanged with the students. Feedback from these interactions can be discussed at the Departmental Mentors Forum or the College Mentoring Committee.
22. **Consultation of Mentors.** All mentors will be consulted or involved in the orientation of students involved in breaches of discipline, attendance and poor academic performance. The opinion of the mentor may be considered by the disciplinary authority before final disposal is given. The students will be required to inform the mentors while applying for leave of absence / extension of vacation.
23. **Peer Mentors.** Each mentor **must** nominate a '**Peer Mentor**' from within the group of mentees. The peer mentoring involves mutual support for academic progression and development of social skills. Peer Mentors must take an initiative in identifying and solving general problems. The Peer Mentors can assist the faculty mentor in mentoring and act as an interlocutor.
24. **Contact with Parents/Local Guardians.** All mentors will make contact with parents and local guardians initially and as and when required by them. Parents can contact mentors for their ward's progress.
25. **Mentoring of Freshers.** Each mentor should interact individually with each fresh member of the group on a regular basis for ascertaining the problems / difficulties if any faced by the freshers in the institution and extending necessary help. It shall be the responsibility of the mentor to coordinate with the Res Warden (BH) and OIC GH. The peer mentors in the group can play a major role assisting the faculty mentors in successful orientation of the freshers to college life.
26. In accordance with National Medical Commission (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges and Institutions) Regulations, 2021; the orientation of fresher

batch will be done in accordance with the SOP notified for Anti-Ragging Measures and Student Mentors.

27. **Use of Social Media.** Mentors can create a closed secret group for faster communication. This could also be used as a channel to communicate SOS messages in an emergency. Social media is a popular medium for exchange of ideas and seeking information, hence, would bond the mentor and the mentee. The mentor is advised to brief the mentees on the SIU Code of Conduct regarding use of social media.

28. **Feedback.** Feedback forms an important part in any decision-making process/system. The Dy Dean Student Welfare in consultation with the Medical Education Unit and NAAC Criteria In-Charge will conduct quarterly online survey and present the feedback at the next meeting of the College Mentoring Committee.

29. **Appreciation.** The good work done by mentors will be appreciated by awarding appreciation letters/certificates by the college. The most popular mentor will be selected by a survey conducted by the Dy Dean Student Welfare among the mentees. Similarly, 'Peer Mentors' will be considered for appreciation and be felicitated during the induction ceremony of the new Student Council.

30. **Conclusion.** The eventual success of any mentorship endeavor hinges upon the profound engagement of mentors in nurturing the growth and evolution of their mentees. It is an intricate play of interpersonal relations, where the mentor's personal investment in the mentee's journey profoundly shapes the trajectory of their development. This involvement transcends mere instruction; it is a symbiotic relationship, where the mentor imparts knowledge, wisdom, and guidance, while the mentee absorbs, learns, and grows under their tutelage. In this altruistic pursuit of mentorship, both mentors and administrators become stewards of enlightenment, nurturing the flames of curiosity and passion within the hearts of the mentees. Together, they form a collective endeavor, fueled by the shared aspiration for academic excellence and the belief in the transformative power of mentorship. It is a noble pursuit, wherein the illumination of young minds illuminates the path to a brighter future for all.

	Appendix A

ROLE AND QUALITIES OF A MENTOR

1. Mentor should function as a role model for the mentees and the student body in general. To this end some of the traits of a role model are given below.

- (i) He/she should lead by example and be successful professionally.
- (ii) Mentors should value integrity and teach their mentees on the importance of integrity.
- (iii) The confidence reposed by the mentee should be held in high regard.
- (iv) Mentors should respect the views of others.
- (v) Mentor should exhibit commitment to his/her goals.

2. Mentor provides necessary guidance and support for the overall development of the mentee.

3. Mentorship is a personal commitment and should be voluntary. Complete involvement of a mentor and his subsequent motivation of a student is the basis of successful mentorship.

4. There are no fixed rules or procedures for Mentors. Only broad based guidelines and advice of experienced teachers can be offered.

5. SMCW provides training to under-graduate students with focus on the ideals of the SIU and the motto '*Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam*'. The experience gained by the faculty members during their long careers can be of good stead for the current day medical students. General grounds for mentoring can be as under.

- (i) Inculcate in the students the qualities of a good doctor.
- (ii) Reinforce in the students the qualities expected of them during their stay in the college and in the future as medical professionals.
- (iii) Emphasize and ensure adequate personal hygiene and grooming including advice on sartorial sense.
- (iv) Motivate the students to maintain their hostel rooms and take interest in general beautification/maintenance of the hostels and campus.
- (v) Guiding the medical students in their pursuit of academic excellence. The mentor may guide the mentee to introspect and find an area of interest in academics and UG research.
- (vi) SMCW believes in the holistic development of young minds. Participation in cultural and social activities is actively encouraged. Mentors can orient the students and motivate them to take up sports and extracurricular activities. This will not only hone their talents but also reduce stress by offering them respite from everyday drudgery.
- (vii) Conscious effort should be made to treat all students equally to the extent possible. This is a women's college so the mentors can contribute to inculcating gender sensitivity amongst the students.
- (viii) Practice of the art of medicine requires appropriate soft skills. The mentors can pay an ideal role model and impart interpersonal communication skills to the mentees.

(ix) The SIU and the college have zero tolerance for alcohol and substance abuse. The mentors can play an active role in educating students about substance abuse and their prevention. Regular interaction with mentees and inputs from peer mentors will help mentors in identifying high-risk students and arrange for needed intervention and treatment.


(x) Mentors will be required to maintain regular touch with the parents/guardians of the mentees. This will give valuable insight into the family background and behavior of the students. Towards the first few months of the stay in SMCW, the students would be confiding more with their parents rather than with peers/mentors. The mentors can play an important role by assuaging the fears of the parents and allaying the concerns of the students. This will help the students to orient them to the college routine at the earliest. This will help them be independent and self-reliant at the earliest.

6. Mentors should monitor the academic progress of their mentees. If required, the mentor should interact with the Student Section/HOD of the relevant departments and obtain the necessary inputs. Gentle motivation to the mentees to be regular in attending classes and studying will help them be focused.

7. Mentors should listen to their mentees in full and without interruption before offering any advice. It is important for the mentors to win the trust of the mentees. Keeping communication channels open and being available to the mentee in times of need is the most important aspect of mentoring.

8. It is important for the mentors to actively encourage the students in their pursuits. The mentors are encouraged to celebrate birthdays and successes of the mentees. Any request for administrative support will be positively considered.



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	Annexure 2

Outline of Mentorship Programme

1. The allotment of mentees to mentors will be coordinated by the Student Section under the aegis of Deputy Dean, Student Welfare. The fresh mentees will be allotted to respective mentors at the beginning of each admission year after the admissions are finalized.
2. Fortnightly meeting of mentors - mentees as a group.
3. Monthly departmental review meeting by HOD with Mentors in their respective departments and report submission to the Member Secretary.
4. Member Secretary to compile reports sent by all HOD'S with respect to students and include in agenda for Meetings of the College Mentoring Committee.
5. Member Secretary to minuted the Meetings of the College Mentoring Committee and submit to Dean
6. At the end of the academic year, individual mentors make a summary of mentor-mentee meetings.
7. Allotment of Freshers to be done at the start of every academic year and records updated as students pass out of the College.
8. Whenever change of mentors takes place Member Secretary to monitor handover of summary and record by previous mentor to newly appointed mentor.
9. The Dean (through Member Secretary) will be immediately informed about any Issue which arises in Mentor-Mentee Meeting/Departmental review meeting that requires urgent attention.



HANDOUT FOR MENTORS

Dos and Don'ts

Dos


1. **Do Bond with Mentees.** Work on developing a close bond with the mentees based on trust and mutual respect.
2. **Maintain Constant Contact.** Maintain constant contact with the mentees and their parents.
3. **Do Listen.** Listen to the mentees carefully and without interruption. This will encourage mentees to come out with their problems and ideas.
4. **Do Know the Background of Mentee.** Know your mentee's family background, hopes and aspirations.
5. **Be Reliable.** Be punctual and schedule your meetings with care. Inform mentees in advance if you have to reschedule meetings.
6. **Maintain Strict Confidentiality.** Respect your mentee's privacy.
7. **Do Focus on Mentee.** Focus on the mentee's needs.
8. **Be Positive.** Identify your mentee's strengths and help him or her learn how to use them.
9. **Be a Role Model.** Be a model by following the highest values in life. Share your experiences and knowledge.
10. **Support.** Offer the mentee assistance when needed. Brief them on how to seek assistance. Brief the mentees on how to seek treatment in case of sickness.
11. **Groom.** Discuss etiquette and polite behavior as required from Doctors and Officers. Brief the cadets on how to keep and maintain their room and personal belongings.
12. **Do Communicate in English.** Motivate mentees to converse in English and develop communication skills.
13. **Do Appreciate.** Take pride in the success of your mentees. Ensure that they get due recognition. Encourage, motivate and praise while being honest and sincere.
14. **Do Keep Records.** Keep meticulous records of interactions.
15. **Do Advise on Tobacco and Substance Abuse.** Discuss the evils of tobacco and alcohol and dissuade cadets from experimenting.
16. **Encourage Independence.** Encourage the mentees to learn on their own. Be a watchful guide.
17. **Celebrate Occasions.** Do celebrate successes and occasions with your group of mentees. Encourage them to know each other and teach them networking.
18. **Do Encourage Balance between Academics and Non-Academic Activities.**
19. Encourage mentees to achieve their full potential and guide them for all round development.
20. Mentoring is akin to parenting or being an older sibling. It is not just being popular or 'goody goody'. It is a responsibility that needs dedication and commitment.

21. Do seek counsel of your HOD or place your problems at appropriate fora. These guidelines are not comprehensive.

Don'ts

1. Don't expect mentees to bond immediately. It takes time.
2. Do not adopt an authoritative tone.
3. Do not act as a substitute for the mentee's parents.
4. Don't be judgmental or impose your opinions.
5. Don't be accommodating. Inculcate a sense of responsibility and propriety in the mentees.
6. Don't get too involved personally in the mentees' personal affairs to the point of being intrusive.
7. Don't violate confidentiality.
8. Do not lend money.
9. Don't appear strict and business-like.
10. Don't take it personally if a mentee does not always heed your advice.
11. Don't forget that there are senior faculty members who are there to help you.

HANDOUT FOR MENTEES

Dos and Don'ts

Dos

1. **Take the initiative:** recognize the need for mentoring and seek it out.
2. **Avoid perfectionism:** accept that you will make mistakes, and learn from them.
3. **Maintain balance:** preserve time for family and friends.
4. **Work hard:** be prepared to give your best.
5. **Support your peers:** exchange personal and professional support with fellow trainees.
6. **Welcome experience:** are enthusiastic about pursuing the widest range of professional experience.
7. **Seek counseling:** solicit advice or counseling if you experience problems with depression, substance abuse, or burnout.

Don'ts

1. **Avoid difficulties:** do not expect mentors to solve all your problems for you.
2. **Sidestep work:** do not expect mentors to do work that you should be doing yourselves.
3. **Stay in your comfort zone:** do not shy away from new learning experiences.
4. **Take advantage:** do not use friendship with a mentor as a tool to avoid work or escape consequences of your own activities.
5. **Bottle it up:** do not avoid talking about problems, anxieties, or grief because it makes you seem less than perfect.
6. **Let your ego get in the way:** recognize that everyone (faculty members, residents, peers, staff and patients) has something to teach you.
