- 1] **Whereas**, the UGC (Institutions Deemed to be University) Regulations, 2019 bearing NOTIFICATION No. F.1-2/2018(CPP-I/DU) dated 20th February, 2019 published in the Gazette of India.
- 2] **And whereas**, the Board of Management vide Resolution No. A5: BoM: 27.06.2019 (i) resolved that the Memorandum of Association (MoA) of Symbiosis International (Deemed University), 2019 in consonance with the UGC [Institutions Deemed to be Universities] Regulations, 2019 be and is hereby accepted.
- 3] **And whereas**, the Board of Management vide Resolution No. A5: BoM: 25.06.2020 has approved the 'Dr. Anandi Gopal Scholarship Scheme' of Symbiosis International (Deemed University). The scholarship will be awarded purely on merit to the top 5 girls who qualify through NEET merit list of students and who get selected and enroll to Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery (M.B.B.S.) Programme at Symbiosis Medical College for Women in the first year
- 4] **Now therefore**, it is hereby notified for information of all the concerned that the "Dr. Anandi Gopal Scholarship Scheme' of Symbiosis International (Deemed University)' is attached as **Appendix A** and will be effective from the date of publication this notification.

***Dr. Anandi Gopal Scholarship Scheme
(Effective from 2020-21)***

Preamble:

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) has approved Dr. Anandi Gopal Scholarship Scheme vide Board of Management meeting held on 27th June, 2019. The scholarship will not be applicable to NRI/ PIOs / OCI card holders / Foreign Nationals i.e. it will be open to Indian Nationals only. The scholarship will be awarded purely on merit. It will be granted to the top 5 girls who qualify through NEET merit list of students and who get selected and enrol to Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery (M.B.B.S.) Programme at Symbiosis Medical College for Women in the first year.

Recommendations of the Committee:

1. Scholarship will be awarded to 5 (Five) Toppers of the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) or any other eligibility cum entrance exam as that may be notified from the Government of India, or any other authority as that may be authorized, who join M.B.B.S. Program offered at Symbiosis Medical College for Women. The amount of scholarship will cover 100% of tuition fees. The other applicable fees including mess and hostel will be borne by the students.
2. The selection of students will be finalized after cut-off date for admission and is subject to authenticity of educational documents of the students from respective issuing authority.
3. There will be no income limit of the parents/guardians of the students for the grant of merit scholarship.
4. In case a student is eligible for more than one scholarship offered either by the University or any other authority, she shall be awarded only one scholarship as per her preference.
5. Each year the Dean will review the performance of the awardees and submit a statement to SIU for continuation of the scholarship after ascertaining attendance/ CGPA etc. as laid down in the policy.

5.a) All awardees must have 80% attendance in theory and practical classes, and must adhere to the norms of moral and ethical conduct as prescribed by the Medical Council of India/ NMC and the University, failing which the scholarship may be discontinued. The final decision regarding cessation/ continuation of scholarship rests with the University authority.

5.b) If a student fails/ does not appear in the University examination twice or more during the entire MBBS programme, her scholarship will be ceased permanently. The student may continue the programme by paying the applicable tuition fees.

5.c) If a student, fails/ does not appear in a University examination once in the total time duration of the MBBS programme, then the scholarship will not be discontinued permanently. As, the MBBS programme is of 9 semesters, means four and half calendar

years, the University will pay the scholarship for only maximum 10 semesters i.e. for 5 calendar years.

6. If a selected student for this scholarship opts for any other scholarships at the beginning of the programme, then this Scholarship will be awarded to the next meritorious student from the same batch.

7. If a student getting this scholarship is punished for misconduct by the University, her scholarship will be stopped permanently. However, she will be given an opportunity to represent herself before the appropriate authority of the University and decision of the University authority will be final and binding.

8. The scholarship amount will not be paid to the student. It will be transferred to the institute by the University.

9. The student selected for scholarship normally apply for No Objection Certificate (NOC) after passing first MBBS examination for transfer to other institution. She shall not be issued NOC by the institution. She has to complete all five and half year MBBS degree programme in SMCW.

10. When the student receiving the scholarship seeks to take transfer after first year of MBBS to another MCI/NMC recognized institute, such student has to pay the fees for the remaining three and half years of MBBS programme along with the return of scholarship so received during the first year of the programme.

11. **After the successful completion of the MBBS programme and completion of internship**, such a student is expected to serve the Symbiosis Medical College for Women for a tenure of at least one year, failing which, the student will have to refund the entire scholarship amount to the University.

a) The student has to undertake (authenticated also by parent) to serve the institution for a period of 1 year after successful completion of the MBBS programme **and completion of internship, in the position of Junior Resident or Tutor. Emoluments as prevalent will be paid to the student.**

b) If the student takes admission for post-graduation, soon after the completion of MBBS, in such case/s, the student/s has to complete the period of one year of service after the completion of post-graduation, **as a Senior Resident in the concerned speciality. Emoluments as prevalent will be paid to the student.**

12. Failing to comply with **point no. 11** above, the student has to return all the scholarship amount of four and half years to the University.

13. All selected students have to sign an undertaking on a bond paper of Rs. 100/- for accepting all the above terms and conditions of this scholarship. This undertaking should also be signed by parents/ guardians.

14. This merit scholarship shall be displayed in public domain by the University. The same will be communicated to the admission authority of Government of India and will be disseminated in all communications of the University as well as the college.
